**RESOLUTION OF THE LAKE~SUMTER METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION (MPO) ENDORSING TRANSMITTAL OF THE ADOPTED 2025 LONG RANGE TRANSPORTATION PLAN (LRTP)**

**WHEREAS**, the Lake~Sumter Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) is designated by the Governor of the State of Florida as the body responsible for the urban transportation planning process for the Lake-Sumter Urban area; and

**WHEREAS**, 23 CFR Section 450.322(a) and Florida Statute 339.175(6) require each Metropolitan Planning Organization to develop and approve a Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP), addressing at least a twenty-year planning horizon, at least every five years; and

**WHEREAS**, a Long Range Transportation Plan includes both long-range and short-range strategies and actions that lead to the development of an integrated intermodal transportation system that facilitates the efficient movement of people and goods; and


**WHEREAS**, the Lake~Sumter Metropolitan Planning Organization's 2025 Long Range Transportation Plan has been prepared in accordance with Chapter 4 of the Florida Department of Transportation MPO Program Management Handbook; and

**WHEREAS**, the Lake~Sumter Metropolitan Planning Organization Board officially adopted the 2025 Long Range Transportation Plan by virtue of a roll-call vote of 11-1 on December 14, 2005.


