The Lake~Sumter Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) is currently seeking Lake County residents to serve on the Transportation Disadvantaged Coordinating Board (TDCB). The purpose of the TDCB is to identify local transportation needs and to provide information, advice and direction to the Community Transportation Coordinator on the coordination of services to be provided to the transportation disadvantaged population within Lake County. In general the TDCB is considered an advisory body.

The board is composed of representatives from local and state governmental agencies as well as a cross section of the local community. The TDCB meets quarterly on Monday afternoons at the Lake~Sumter MPO located on US 27 in Leesburg, FL.
